


After a successful pilot year. IDSA is proud to appound the official launch

After a successful pilot year, IDSA is proud to announce the official launch of the **2019 CORE Antimicrobial Stewardship Curriculum**. This updated product will be available for purchase within our LMS in July of 2019.

PRICING STRUCTURE:



- Fellow and faculty access to the curriculum is designed to be purchased together so it is strongly encouraged to purchase access for at least ONE
 Faculty member. This ensures access to manage fellow completions and attendence, exclusive video content for classroom facilitation, along with new updated documents, citations, and references to be sure that faculty and fellow materials align.
- The curriculum is designed to be incorporated into existing Infectious Diseases (ID) Fellowship training program curricula. To accommodate varying AS resources at home institutions; the curriculum includes direction on how to use the various educational activities in order to capitalize on or augment existing AS resources for both fellows and faculty. Estimated time for completion: 4-5 hours for faculty, 11 hours for fellows and self -study
